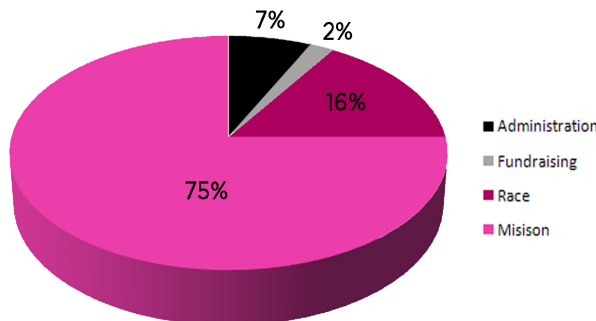

OPPORTUNITIES

The Greater Evansville Affiliate had the opportunity to partner, not once, but twice, with the Susan G. Komen for the Cure Tissue Bank at IU Simon Cancer Center – the only tissue repository in the world! The Tissue Bank conducted the largest one-time collection of normal breast tissue from Latina women and our local Affiliate transported over 50 Latina women to Indianapolis to donate. The citizens of our tri-state overwhelmed the Tissue Bank with their support of the blood collection at the 12th annual Greater Evansville Race for the Cure in 2009. More than 200 volunteers donated their time and talent to draw and process blood from 1,362 donors. This collection broke all records for number of samples collected in one day – 350 more donors than in Dallas, Texas the previous year! Every informed consent form, alcohol swab and needle that was available was used in the collecting of samples from the people who had made it a priority to come to the tent to contribute a sample of their blood to breast cancer research. As a result of these two events, researchers around the world can use these samples in their quest to end breast cancer.

In 2009, the Greater Evansville Affiliate awarded **21 grants** to 19 organizations totaling **\$601,783**.
